NOTICE OF PEREMPTORY CALENDAR

Pursuant to Rule 20 of the Uniform Superior Court Rules, the Clerk of State Court is DIRECTED to publish a list of the following civil actions in which the discovery period has expired, requiring the parties or their attorneys to announce whether the cases appearing thereon are ready for trial and when trial should be scheduled. Failure to appear at the calendar sounding or otherwise to advise the judge or staff attorney of the status of the case may result in the dismissal without prejudice of plaintiff's action or defendant's answer, counterclaim or cross-claim.

To advise the judge that a case is active, disposed of or has been dismissed and should be removed from the peremptory calendar, or to submit a proposed order disposing of a case, send an email no later than forty-eight hours before the calendar call to

Neither parties nor attorneys are required to appear if the judge has been advised that the matter remains active. The parties, through counsel, are encouraged to contact the Court through email in advance of the calendar rather than appear.
