STANDING ORDER GOVERNING PLEAS TO TRAFFIC CHARGES Effective Immediately

In all cases involving traffic offenses (Title 40) where a plea has been negotiated between the State and a Defendant, at the time of presenting the underlying facts, the prosecutor (Assistant Solicitor) handling the case shall inform the judge of the following:

- 1. Notify the Court if the Defendant Driver holds a Commercial Drivers License (CDL) or CDL permit, or at any time, including at the time of the incident, held a CDL;
- 2. Notify the Court if the underlying incident involved a collision; and
- 3. If there was a collision, notify the Court as to whether there was injury to any person or damage to any property and the extent thereof.

In any case involving a Defendant who is or was the holder of a CDL or CDL permit, the prosecutor should be prepared to inform the Court with specificity of the factual or evidentiary basis for any reduction in charges.
